Facebook Photos

Facebook is the number one photo sharing site on the internet. Photo albums are easy to share with people on and off Facebook. As you do so, you will learn how to "tag" yourself and your friends so that people will easily be able to see a history of photos of you.

Profile Picture

To upload a profile picture:

- Place your mouse over the upper right corner of your current profile picture or temporary image, and click on the pencil icon that appears.
- Select "Browse" to find a photo on your computer to upload.
- Select the photo to upload
- Check the box certifying that you have the right to distribute the picture and that it is not pornography
- Click "upload picture." If the picture is an acceptable size and file type, it will display.
- You can also set any photo in which you are tagged as your profile picture by viewing the photo and selecting "Make Profile Picture."

Webcam Profile Picture

- If you have a webcam attached to your computer you can use it to add a new profile picture. To use the webcam: Go to your profile.
- Hover your mouse over your current profile picture and click the "Change Picture" link that appears.
- On the following page you will have the option to use a webcam if one is available.
- Click the Camera button at the bottom of the preview image.
- Smile.
- Select 'Save Picture' once you are satisfied with the image.

Thumbnail Version

- The "Thumbnail Version" of your profile picture is used in certain places around the site, such as the upper left hand corner of your application (e.g., photos) pages.
- To adjust what part of your profile picture serves as the thumbnail, hover your mouse over your current profile picture.
- Click the "Change Picture" link that appears.
- Select the "Edit Thumbnail" option.

Edit Profile Pictures

- Edit my profile
- Mouse over picture (or where picture should be)
- Select Add a picture. No picture looks unprofessional and incomplete.
- Upload Picture

Delete Old Profile Pictures

- If you want to delete an old profile picture, first view the album by clicking on your current profile picture.
- When you are viewing the album, you should see an option for Edit Photos at the top of the page.
- On the edit page, you are given the option to delete any of the images, as well as to tag them or add captions.
- Once you delete the photo, no one will be able to see it when they view your profile picture album.

Old Profile Photos

- To see a history of all your old profile photos, just go to the Profile page and click on your current profile picture. It will bring you to an album of all your profile photos. When you are viewing your old profile pictures, you will have the option to tag them, add captions, or delete them from the album.
- Any user who can see your profile can see the profile pictures you have in this album. To view someone else's old profile pictures, just click on their current profile picture while viewing their profile.

Photo Albums

- Click on your Name in the upper right of the page
- Select Photo
- Create a Photo Album
- Name your photo album. Make sure this name is concise and clearly identifies the general contents of the album.
- Privacy options; it is best to leave these photos open to Everyone so that your images can reach as many people as possible.

Photo Albums

- Next, you will be prompted to upload photos.
- Click the “Try the Simple Uploader” link towards the bottom of the page.
- Browse your hard drive and input the file paths into individual fields.
- Write a brief caption for each picture.
- You can also identify the people or objects in each photo by “tagging” them. By clicking anywhere on the photo itself, you will be able to tag, or label, the photos.
- The benefit of setting tags is that visitors can find your photos simply by using a search bar.

Photo Albums
